Pritzker Philanthropic Family Values

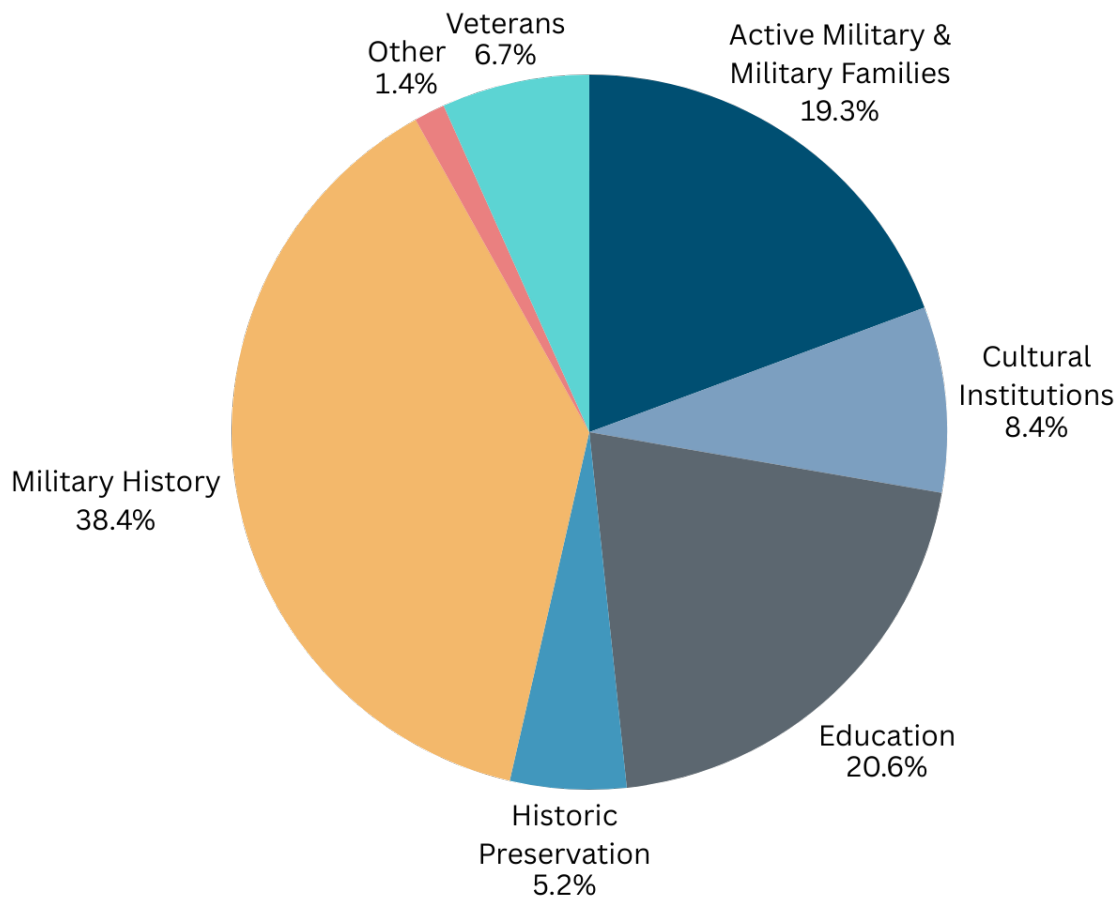

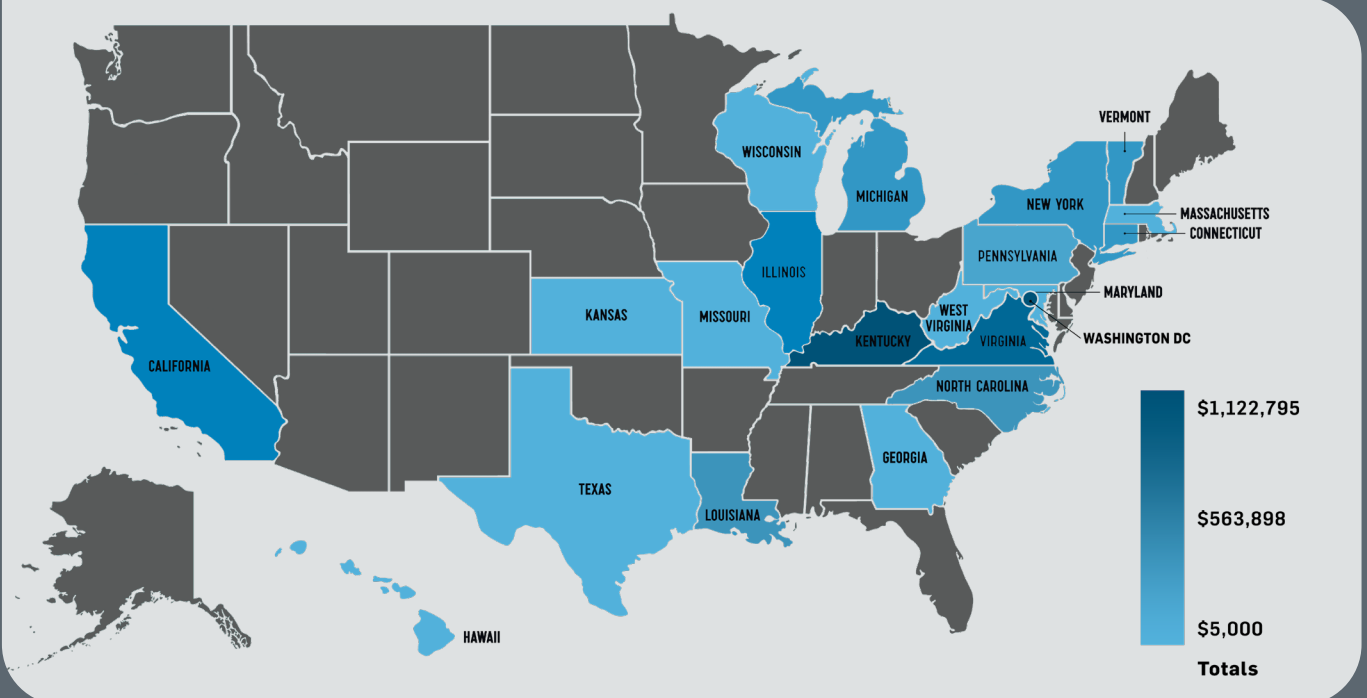
